HISTORY & VISION

Launched by Chay Yew shortly after he came to VG in 2011 as the company's first Artistic Director in 34 years, The Chicago Play Cycle commissions, develops and produces new plays that reflect and represent the neighborhoods and diverse communities of Chicago in contemporary and historical times; creating stories that resonate with broader audiences simultaneously through the universality and humanity of their themes, and the specificity of time and place. To date, the Chicago Play Cycle has generated seven world premieres, with an eighth, *Dhaba on Devon* Avenue by Madhuri Shekar to premiere in 2020, with Chay Yew directing.

Thus far, four of the Chicago Cycle plays have gone on to be produced at theaters across the country, helping to advance the playwrights' careers and VG's visibility as a center for new play development.
